Upon Registration

- You will receive newsletters Via email the first of each month starting in Sept 2008.
- You will receive your own mailbox (file folder) located in the front lobby at ADA. Your mailbox is labeled with your child's last name. You will receive your account statements and various memos through this mailbox. Please check your mailbox every time you come in.
- Auburn Dance Academy accepted form of payment is Auto debit from a debit or credit card.
- There is an annual \$20 registration fee that is due upon registration.
- Tuition and related fees for classes is debited on the first of each month.
- There is a \$25 return fee for any and all NSF transactions.
- There is a costume fee for each dance performed in the **June Production** Due by February first
 - Levels pre to 2=\$55.00
 - Levels 3 - 4= \$60.00
 - Level 5-7 = \$65.00
- There is a costume fee for each dance performed in the **Christmas Production**
 - \$15.00 per class costume purchase or rental fee Due By November first.
 - Student may have to provide and purchase accessories to their costumes.
 - Some classes rent costume pieces from ADA and some purchase. This is determined. by management.
- Tickets for Auburn Dance Academy Shows are available for purchase for \$13 on pre-sale day and \$15 there after

What Do I need for class?

- All items needed to participate in dance classes are for sale in **ADA's On Site Dancewear Boutique.**
- Auburn Dance Academy's policy of proper attire is designed to promote an atmosphere in which dance students can learn and thrive. The dress code will be strictly enforced. Dancers not dressed to code may be asked to sit and watch the lesson for that day. There are no refunds due to dress code violations.



- Ballet attire is appropriate for every class.
- No jewelry or gum.

Ballet

Hair: Must be in a bun, all bangs must be pushed back or to the side. Short hair must be pulled back half way in a barrette. No headbands.

Shoes: Pink split sole ballet slippers with elastic strap properly attached.

Attire: Solid color leotard, pink tights. A Ballet wrap skirt is optional. For levels 1-2. No skirts for levels 3-7



Jazz/Lyrical/Acro/Musical Theater/ Tap level 6-7

Hair: Must be up in a ponytail or bun with bangs securely pinned back.

Shoes: Black split sole jazz shoes (jazz) Foot Undez (lyrical). Bare feet (Acro).

Attire: Leotard or sports bra. Tight black Jazz pants or boy shorts. Please own both.



Pre dance through Level 5 dancers must have hair in bun for all disciplines of dance.

Hip Hop

Hair: No hair requirement

Shoes: Matching Performance Sneakers dedicated to the dance floor (purchased @ADA).

Attire: Absolutely no jeans of any kind. Otherwise dress at your own discretion.

Administrative Policies

Accepted Payment Methods

- Fees must be paid by auto debit with a debit or Credit Card. Fees will be debited monthly from the card you provide the first day of each month from September through June. Charge will appear on your bank or credit card statement as being from Auburn Dance Academy. Incidental purchases such as show tickets, dancewear, shoes etc, can be purchased at ADA boutique. We no longer accept checks.
- You may pre-pay on your account at anytime.
- If you prefer, you can pay all fees for the entire season up front By credit card, debit card, or money order.

Refunds and Missed Classes

- There are no tuition refunds due to absence, however your child has the option of attending a similar class to make up the absence. Please inquire at the front desk for assistance.
- There are no refunds on tuition, dancewear, shoes, or costuming.
- Monthly tuition is divided into equal payments for lessons received for a full 9-month dance session (September - June), NOT on lessons per month. Payments remain the same each month regardless of attendance, school closures, or holidays)
- **Clients must have a zero account balance in order to participate in the Holiday or June Productions.**

Attendance

- If you want your child to progress, good attendance is very important. Each dance level has a certain curriculum; excessive absences put a dancer behind his or her class. Please contact the studio if your child will be absent due to illness or other commitments.

Withdrawing From Class

- If you wish to withdraw from lessons, you must do so in writing 30 days in advance. Your account will be debited until proper withdrawal form is turned in and the full procedure is followed.

Holidays and Vacation



- In the event of snow, call the studio to verify that classes are in session. A message will be recorded on the voicemail.
- Auburn Dance Academy will be closed the following days:
 - Labor Day
 - Halloween
 - Thanksgiving Break
 - From the Holiday Production until the First business day after New Years Day
 - Memorial Day Weekend
 - The 2 weeks following the June Production
 - The 2 weeks following the last day of summer session

Studio Rental

- Studio room rental for room one, two, or three: \$25.00 per hour
- Studio room rental for room four: \$20.00 per hour
- Full studio Rental: \$100.00per hour

Late Parents

- If you are more than 20 minutes late to pick up your student, you can expect a \$1 per minute charge on your account for time over 20 mins. You will receive one warning in writing before the charge is added to your account

Private Lessons

- You may schedule private lessons with any of the Auburn Dance Academy instructors.
- Private lesson fees are paid directly to the instructor upon scheduling the lesson. Fees may vary.
- 24 hours notice must be given for a full refund. 50% refund if you fail to cancel with 24 hour notice.

Dance Etiquette

- Dancers are encouraged to be at class fully dressed and on time. If for some reason you are late, students are still encouraged to come to class. Please wait in the viewing window for the instructor to wave you into class.
- Inside the classroom there will be no talking while the instructor is teaching.
- The phrase "I can't" will not be tolerated and may result in push-ups.

Please see the Xtreme Dance Policy for Specific information.

New To ADA?

- Is this your first show? If so, you are invited to attend an informal Q and A session with the owners, Jennifer Carrington and Annalise Espinosa . They will walk you through the entire show experience and answer all of your questions.

All Cast Rehearsals/ extra rehearsals

- In the month of December and June ADA call 2-3 all cast rehearsals. There is a \$2.00 per child/ per class charge.

Parent Volunteers

- Parent volunteers are needed for all Pre Ballet/Tap Classes, & dance Levels 1-3.
- Volunteers must be present for both dress rehearsal and the production.
- You will be able to watch your dancer perform from the on stage wings.
- All volunteers will receive one complimentary Production ticket.
- Parent volunteer meeting is scheduled for the month of June.

Ticket Information

- Ticket pre- sale day is the first Saturday In December and June
- Please do not line up before 6am
- Staff will purchase tickets the Thur. before Ticket day. A section of seats will not be available for purchase by staff.
- There is reserved seating with a TBA ticket limit per show.
- Tickets are \$13 on pre-sale day and are \$15 there after.
- There are no returns or exchanges. No exceptions.
- You must have ticket to re-enter theater.
- Children over the age of 5 must have their own seat. Children 5 and under may sit on the lap of a parent for free.
- Cash and check only on pre sale ticket day.

Dress/ Tech Rehearsal

- Drop off your dancer with the dressing room manager at their scheduled check in time.
- Only Authorized personal will be permitted in the dressing rooms.
- Have your dancer dressed in costume with make up and hair complete when you arrive.
- Dress rehearsal is **closed** to all observers including parents.
- Please be punctual. Child pick up times are approximate.

Showtime

- Showtime is at **7:00pm**
- All dancers should arrive @ **6:15pm** and report to the dressing room manager at the door of the main dressing room.
- Please have dancers use the restroom before they check-in.

Pre-Ballet Tap Classes

- Parents may drop off their dancer at 6:45pm. The children will be escorted to their special pre-dance room
- You may pick up your dancer at intermission in the main dressing rooms **BACK DOOR**. They may watch the show sitting on your lap. They do not need a ticket.
- Pre-Ballet/ Tap students do not participate in curtain call.

Production Policy:

- No flash photography in either show. No video cameras in June Show.
- No food or beverages inside the theater.
- All students level 1-7 must stay backstage in designated areas (there will be a live feed TV to view the show).

Production Services

- Message Hearts are a way to get your message to your dancer through the ADA Production

Grooming Instructions for a Show

For all dancers during Picture Week, Dress Rehearsal , and The Productions

- No underwear or jewelry
- No fingernail polish or toenail polish
- Stage make-up
 - Foundation
 - Powder
 - Blush
 - Gray eye shadow
 - Black eyeliner
 - Black mascara
 - Dark Red lipstick
 - With the exception of Hip Hop and characters, dancers hair is parted on the right and slicked into a bun on the back of the head (not the top). Secure with a black hair net and bobby pins. **NO BIG BUN COVERS OR SCRUNCHIES THAT ARE NOT A PART OF YOUR COSTUME.**
 - Hip Hop Dancers may wear their hair in any style. Please think about quick changes. A bun is acceptable for Hip Hop Hair. You may want to get a hair extension piece in order to change hair quickly
 - Pre Dance students may lighten makeup as needed.
- Hair Instructional demonstration will be given prior to Picture week.
- Auburn Dance Academy dancers use Bloch brand tights. ADA sell's Bloch brand for your convenience.
- You may purchase the following products from the ADA Dancewear Boutique for use at the show
 - BODY GLITTER:** Body glitter is a great way to stand out on stage.
 - RHINESTONED FOOT UNDEZ:** Apply pack of Swarovski Crystal Rhinestones for your foot undez
 - HAIR JEWELS:** Add three rhinestones to your part for a nice touch



Picture Week

At Auburn Dance Academy

- Class pictures will generally take place during regular class time during the first week of June .
- A specific schedule is distributed at a later time
- Please arrive dressed and ready 5-10 minutes before the listed time. Please wear stage make-up and hair.
- During picture week, each class rehearses and is pictured.
- **Saturday Students and Xtreme Routines are scheduled throughout the week**
- Your teacher will provide 2 or 3 poses you can choose from, or you can create one of your own.
- If you do not purchase pictures, please get your child's picture taken with the group.
- Xtreme Members and Characters with Solo and Duo's: Please sign up at the front counter for a designated time if you want your solo or duo picture taken. Your choreographer may or may not be present for your picture.
- Wear your full warm-up and White tennis shoe for the Xtreme Team picture.
- If your child is not participating in the production, we recommend that you do not attend picture day.
- Cascade West has a representative at ADA the weeks prior to picture week. You may pre order your picture packages and ask questions at that time.
- Parents should accompany their dancers to choose picture packages.
- You must order and pre-pay your packages before your photos are taken.
- Credit Cards are accepted.
- Pictures are delivered to the studio in 6-8wks after picture week.

Star Success Program

Keep your child's dance education on track with ADA's Star Program. Participating in ADA's Star Program is an easy way to ensure a confident performer at every age and level. Get started today!

- **Mini Star Program** for Pre- Dance level:
 - Must be enrolled in **one** Pre dance class per week to start your dancer off right.
- **Shinning Star Program** for level 1 and 2:
 - Must be enrolled in **3 hours** of dance per week.
- **Super Star Program** for level 3 and 4:
 - Must be enrolled in **4 hours** of dance per week.
- **Rock Star Program** for level 5 and 6:
 - Must be enrolled in **5 hours** of dance per week.
- **Elite Star Program** for level 7:
 - Must be enrolled in **6 hours** of dance per week.



Star Program Annual Graduation

- Upon completion of the Star Program, ADA holds a graduation Ceremony and Celebration! Celebrate your Child's accomplishments!
- Each student will receive a Certificate of Achievement and a Trophy to symbolize their accomplishment.
- After the graduation ceremony we throw an **exclusive party** for the graduates and their parents.

- \$25.00 per dancer fee to participate in the Graduation Ceremony and Celebration.

ADA Studio Wide Discipline Procedure

- ADA has adopted a specific discipline procedure in order to give each dancer a productive learning environment. If you see a problem in any class, please bring the issue to the attention of the receptionist.
- Rules are set for each class specific warning system is included.

Levels 3-7

The teacher will complete a "Removal from Class" form for a problem student. Parents will receive this form via mail. The removed student is sent to the front desk office. He or she loses privileges such as phone calls, & homework. The student maybe asked to rejoin the class. The instructor will speak with the student after class. A parent conference maybe necessary.

Pre Ballet and Tap through Level 2

Give warning. A disruptive student may be asked to "Sit out." The end of class treat maybe withheld. Parent will be contacted after class

Model/ Photo Release

1. By Registering for classes at Auburn Dance Academy, the legal Guardian of the student (if under 21 years of age) hereby grants to Auburn Dance Academy ("ADA"), his/her heirs, legal representatives, and assigns, those for whom ADA is acting, and those acting with his/her authority and permission (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Users"), the irrevocable and unrestricted right and permission to take, use, re-use, publish, and republish photographic portraits or pictures of the Model including, without limitation, reproductions thereof in which the Model may be included, in whole or in part (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Photographs").
2. ADA may be used for illustration, promotion, art, editorial, advertising, trade, in formats including but not limited to television and motion pictures, magazines, books, video recordings, audio recordings or other media, known or unknown at this time, or any other lawful purpose whatsoever.
3. The Model hereby waives any right to inspect or approve the finished product or products and the advertising copy or other matter that may be used in conjunction therewith or the use to which it may be applied.

XTREME Team Policy

- Xtreme represents Auburn Dance Academy's Elite dancers. Acceptance into Xtreme is by audition only. Xtreme Team specialize in competing and performing in order to prepare for a career in the dance and entertainment industry. It is ADA's belief that competitive dance is a sport that gauges the skill level of our dancers to that of their peers in a positive, fun atmosphere.

Commitment and Time Requirements

- Approximately one year commitment
- Failure to follow the Xtreme attendance policy may result in removal from the team.
- There are no refunds on any payments that were already made.



- **Xtreme Auditions**

- Annually scheduled for August of each year
- Students audition for placement in Xtreme Routines

- **Choreography Camp**

- Annually Schedule 4 day block of time for late August, Sept of each year
- Students learn a large portion of their Xtreme routines in this camp
- All Xtreme Team Members are required to participate in this camp.
- Failure to attend will result in exclusion from the piece being taught.

- **Weekly classes September through August**

- Students maintain and improve skills
- Attending class regularly is required. Make up all missed classes in an equal or lower level class.
- Please submit an "Excused Absence Form" to the front desk 2 wks prior to your absence.

- **Mandatory Weekly Xtreme Rehearsals**

- Xtreme Students will learn, clean, and rehearsal their competition routines in these rehearsals.
- Please schedule family dinners, parties, and other personal events around these dates and times.
- Good attendance ensures that choreography doesn't have to be re-taught due to student absences.
- All Xtreme dancers must be present to rehearsal the week before a competition. Absent dancers will not compete.
- All dancers must be present for all National rehearsals in the summer in order to compete at nationals.

- **Annual Saturday Rehearsals**

- In the month of January ADA holds required Xtreme rehearsals.

- **Emergency Rehearsals**

- If there is a need for an emergency rehearsal it will be called with parent approval

- **Competitions/ Conventions**

- One mock competition
- Three local competition
- One required convention for level 3 and up.
- One out of state competition which is a week long trip.

- **Guest Teacher Classes**

- ADA gives the Xtreme Students the opportunity to take class from a variety of different instructors (participation required)

Competitive Solos, Duos, Trios Private Lessons

- Please show your interest a on your Xtreme request form which is passed out at auditions.
- Soloist and duo/trio partners competing in Jazz, Lyrical, Musical Theater, Character, Tap, or Open are required to take one extra Ballet tech class per week in addition to their Xtreme requirements.
- If selected, you will be required to pay for private lessons to learn your dance. Private lessons are scheduled at your instructor's discretion.
 - **Fees**
 - § Solos-at choreographers/ teachers discretion. (approximately \$40-\$65 per hour)
 - § Duos - at choreographers/ teachers discretion in relation to the teacher solo cost
 - § Trios- at choreographers/ teachers discretion in relation to the teacher solo cost
- All private lessons will be posted on the instructors sign up sheets on the front counter, or emailed to you.
- Private lessons must be paid for before scheduling in this studio room time log book.
- For levels 6 and 7 minimum of 12 lessons may be required to learn and clean your solo, duo, or trio before the competition season starts in January .
- Levels 1– 5 may require weekly lessons.
- Dancers must attended or make up their weekly ballet classes in order to be scheduled for private lessons. **NEW!**
- Please see Private lessons Portion of the ADA handbook for additional policy (page 3)

Competitions/Conventions/Performances

- The new competition schedule will be released in October at the latest.
- In addition to the required competitions, We will offer a schedule of additional competitions and convention for those dancers who would like participate, please sign up at the front desk to attend extra competitions.
- All competition fees are charged by the Competition Company, not ADA.
- **Xtreme Showcase/Mock Competition at a PAC.**
 - Early in the season we hold a Mock Competition in which our own team competes against each other.
 - The fee is \$8.00 per dancer per routine.
- **Performances**
 - Malls, charity events, YMCA, Key Arena, Winterfest, Fairs, parades, sporting events performance opportunities are provided.
 - Sign up on the Information Center to participate
- **On Competition Day**
 - Dancers must be at the competition dressed and ready to go on stage 2 hours before your scheduled time.
 - Routines will not be held for late arrivals and competition fees will not be refunded
 - All dancers must be backstage (dressed and made up) 15 routines before their scheduled routine.
 - The exact performance time for your routine will not be known until the **Tuesday** before the competition.
 - Xtreme Team Members are **required** to wear ADA cover-ups for the awards and in the theater.
- **Trophies and Awards**
 - Awarded given to groups will be property of Auburn Dance Academy. They will be displayed.
 - Solo/ duo/ trio trophies are kept by the dancers
 - Trophies are on sale at all the competitions so each dancer can purchase one if they wish.
 - The dancer who take the trophy home from the competition should neatly attach a label with the routine name on it. Then, bring it back to the studio for display.
 - Prize money is subject to 20% government taxes. The remainder will be divided between the winners.

Apparel and Make-up

- **Competition Costumes**
 - One for each Routine choreographed will be distributed in January
 - Parents are expected to embellish costume with rhinestones provided
- **Fanale Costume**
 - Dancers are expected to produce an inexpensive costume for their part in Holiday and June shows
- **Xtreme Warm up suit**
 - Xtreme members can purchase their Nike Training Suit from Soccer West.

Physical

- ADA requires all Level 5 through 7 team members Must have an annual Doctors Physical.

School sports and Commitments

- **Activity Request**

- If an Xtreme Dancer wants to participate in an after school activity please request an approval through your Choreographer/ Coach.
- Please fill out a request form and turn it into the front counter.
- The leader of your other activity must complete their portion of the request form.
- No excused absences from rehearsals or regular class will be given for an extra Activities.

-Please submit a letter from your school teacher explaining your project and activity if you have a graded school commitment.
